

AW2400 OS software version up manual<CD>

How to version up via CD-R

1. Please copy the latest file 'AW2400PG.BIN' onto your CD-R(ISO format) and put the CD-R on the CD tray.
2. Turn off the power of AW2400.

And turn on again the power with pushing the following both keys.

WORK NAVIGATE "SONG"key
 "MIDI"key

```
//// AW2400 OS UPDATER ////
```

```
CHECKING HDD...  
LOADING OS FROM CD-ROM...
```

3. After a few minutes, the LCD display will be as following. Press the "Enter" key.
(the following display is the example of version up from V1.00 to V1.01.)

```
//// UPDATE OS VERSION ////
```

```
FIRM OS: V1.10    <- V1.00
```

```
DO YOU WANT TO UPDATE?  
CONTINUE: [ENTER], EXIT: [CANCEL]
```

4. After showing the message as following on the LCD,
installation of the latest software will start.

```
//// UPDATE OS VERSION ////
```

```
FIRM OS: V1.10    <- V1.00
```

```
DO YOU WANT TO UPDATE?  
CONTINUE: [ENTER], EXIT: [CANCEL]
```

```
WRITING OS INTO AW2400.  
PLEASE DON'T TOUCH AW2400!!
```

Caution) As the messages will be on the LCD,
please don't touch AW2400 until showing the result of updating.

5. After completing the installation, the following message will be on the bottom of the LCD.

```
RESTART: [ENTER]
```

So please push the "enter" key and reboot the OS.

```
DO YOU WANT TO UPDATE?  
CONTINUE: [ENTER], EXIT: [CANCEL]
```

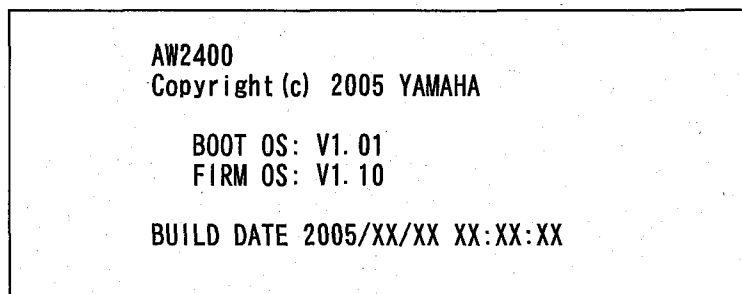
```
WRITING OS INTO AW2400.  
PLEASE DON'T TOUCH AW2400!!
```

```
COMPLETED.  
RESTART: [ENTER]
```

The updating is completed.

To confirm the version info

Turn on the power of AW2400. After showing YAMAHA logo,
please push the "UTILITY" key.
After pushing as it is, the installed OS version will be on the LCD.



Please confirm your firm version is changed as the display showing.

About the display messages

"CAN'T LOAD OS FILE."

The OS files is not found.

After confirm the file, please try again to make version up from the beginning.

"INCOMPLETED. PLEASE TURN OFF"

The version up is imcompleted.
